Teachers will ensure these resources are allocated appropriately to all students throughout the year.

Financial Support for Families

North Melbourne Primary School understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers a range of support options, including:

- payment plans

CSEF

Families holding a valid means-tested concession card or temporary foster parents are eligible to apply for the Camps, Sports and Excursions (CSEF) funding - \$125.00 per child. This money can be used to help cover the costs of camps, excursions, incursions and or swimming. CSEF applications are open from the first day of term one 2021. Parents or legal guardians are required to submit a new CSEF application form each year.
